Brief Profile of Most Rev. Prof. Emmanuel Asante

Most Reverend Prof. Emmanuel Asante, an Alumnus of Christian Service University, is an Academic, Theologian and Reverend Minister. He served as the third Presiding Bishop of the Methodist Church Ghana from 2009 to 2015. He is the immediate past Chairman of the National Peace Council. In 2022, the United Nations Secretary-General António Guterres appointed Most Rev. Prof. Emmanuel Asante to the ten-member Advisory Group of the United Nations Peacebuilding Fund for a term of two years.

Most Rev. Asante served as Adjunct Lecturer with his alma mater, Christian Service University College, (1987-1994), Chairman of Council, Christian Service College, (1992-1994), Senior Lecturer and Associate Professor, Trinity Theological Seminary, (1994-2006), Head of Department of Religious Studies, Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology, (2006-2009). He has also served as an external examiner in Religious Studies in a number of tertiary institutions, and as a consultant on Religious Studies, National Accreditation Board.
